Immunization Requirements

Students are expected to have their immunizations up-to-date by the **first day of school, or they will be excluded from school.** This year the Howard County Health Department will be holding three walk-in clinics at local schools where students can receive required vaccines. Flyers in Spanish and English are attached. If a parent indicates to Health Room staff that they will attend one of the clinics that week, the student will be allowed to remain in school. Should the student not attend the clinic and remains out of compliance, they MUST be excluded from school until the immunization is up-to-date. <u>HCHD Clinic Schedule</u>.
